

1. SPELEOLOGY (volcanic caves) 2. HISTORIC PATHS

- 1. It will consist of an environmental interpretation of nature in the park, especially those related to the Volcano and the volcanic**



caves.

- o The place of meeting will be always at the reception of the state-owned hotel (Parador), where our services will start.**
- o The minimum of people in a group must be 10 and the maximum 20. If a larger group wishes to do the activity, it will be divided into sub-groups.**
- o The activity will take us about 3 and 4 hours, depending on the objectives and routes proposed.**
- o Previous knowledge on speleology is not required and anyone could do the activity (except some exceptions).**
- o The volcanic caves we attempt to visit are inside the National Park territory. Visits to other different caves (e.g. “Cueva del Viento Sobrado”) must be agreed and paid according to the objectives.**

People who do this activity strictly must follow all the instructions fixed by TeideAstro staff.

Any other condition, apart from what's been said above, could be regarded according to specific characteristics of each group.



2. Other important route that of ancient “sanatorium”, departing from “Montaña de Majúa” (at the foot of the sky-lift) towards the “Circo de las Cañadas”. The objectives are the environmental interpretation. The staff of the National Park will always establish these ways.

There will be stops in ancient settings, which were useful for the “Sanatorio de las Cañadas”. This implies a historic interpretation of the healthy antecedents since the beginnings of 20th century almost till nowadays, meaning the historic importance that the National Park has had for muleteers, coal merchants, sulphur merchants, etc. This aspect is hardly known by the visitors. (Any story about the relation man-environment could be available).

This route, after passing by “Cañadas de Mareta” and the “Capricho”, goes to back to the state-owned hotel (Parador), after a 3 hours walk.

Both possibilities (“Las Cañadas” and the “Ruta del Sanatorio”) are unheard-of and exclusive for no conventional groups.

FOOD is not included (except previous agreement).
